

**RESOLUTION NO. 2017-18**

A RESOLUTION declaring as surplus to the City of Ellensburg's needs the 2001 solar energy demonstration systems that were acquired by the electric utility.

WHEREAS, the City Council conducted a public hearing on July 3, 2017, in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 2.07 ECC and RCW 35.94.040, for the purpose of declaring certain items as surplus to the City electric utility's needs; and


WHEREAS, public notice of the hearing was first published in accordance with the provisions of ECC 2.07.080.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELLENSBURG AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The list of electric utility property below is hereby declared surplus to the City of Ellensburg's needs and the items are no longer required for providing municipal services. Disposal of materials shall be by junking, public auction, sealed bid, or sale to any qualified nonprofit corporation at fair market value. The estimated fair market value of the below surplus utility property is \$50.

14 – 85 Watt Solar Panels  
2 – 1,500 watt Trace Suntie Inverters  
1 – Lot UNIRAC U-GR roof racking  
1 – Lot pole mount racking  
1 - Selectric Signs LED Sign
