

ORDINANCE NO. 4778

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELLENSBURG, WASHINGTON, RELATING TO THE BUSINESS DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY - CHAPTER 1.62 OF THE ELLENSBURG CITY CODE AND AMENDING SECTION 1.62.120 TO ADOPT AN AMENDED CHARTER FOR THE ELLENSBURG BUSINESS DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY (EBDA).

WHEREAS, the City of Ellensburg wishes to engage in economic development activities and programs; and

WHEREAS, the Ellensburg City Council by Ordinance 3895, adopted December 15, 1993 created the Ellensburg Business Development Authority and approved a Charter for the Authority's operation; and

WHEREAS, Section 1.62.120 of the Ellensburg City Code, as last amended by Ordinance No. 4623, requires approval by ordinance of any amendment to the EBDA Charter; and

WHEREAS, the City Council, after giving notice pursuant to ECC 1.62.120, conducted a public hearing on October 16, 2017 to receive testimony on the proposed Charter amendments; and

WHEREAS, at its October 16, 2017 regular meeting, following a public hearing, the City Council considered amendments to the EBDA Charter proposed by the EBDA Board and the City Attorney;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Ellensburg, Washington do hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1. Section 1.62.120 "Charter" of Ellensburg City Code chapter 1.62 – Business Development Authority, as last amended by Section 1 of Ordinance 4623, is hereby amended by the adoption of a new charter, attached hereto as Exhibit A to this ordinance as though fully set forth herein.

Section 2. Severability. If any portion of this ordinance is declared invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion(s) of this ordinance.

Section 3. Corrections. Upon the approval of the City Attorney, the City Clerk and the codifiers of this ordinance are authorized to make necessary corrections to this ordinance including, but not limited to, the correction of scrivener's/clerical errors, references, ordinance numbering, section/subsection numbers and any references thereto.

Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage, approval and publication.

The foregoing ordinance was passed and adopted at a regular meeting of the City Council on the 6th day of November, 2017.
