

**RESOLUTION NO. 2019-11**

A RESOLUTION authorizing the Police Dept. to remove three street trees at 100 N. Pearl St;

WHEREAS, ECC 4.36.380 requires that any person, firm or corporation may apply for the removal of street trees, subject to city council approval, under such conditions and requirements as set forth in the Ellensburg City Code;

WHEREAS, Police Dept. has requested permission to remove three street trees;


WHEREAS, the City Arborist has reviewed the condition of the trees and the proposed replanting of the trees, and recommends the City Council authorize removal of the trees;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELLENSBURG, WASHINGTON,  
DO RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Police Dept. is authorized to remove three street trees located at 100 N. Pearl St. Approval to remove the trees is conditioned upon the Police Dept. first receiving a Street Tree Permit and Public Works Permit from the City of Ellensburg Public Works & Utilities Department for removal of the trees at their expense including removal of the stumps, and replanting three replacement trees from the City's Street Tree List in the City right of way in an approved location or pay \$700 into the city's tree fund (the cost of three 1½" diameter replacement trees), within one year.

Section 2. Removal of the stumps shall be done within 30 days of the removal of the trees.
