

**RESOLUTION NO. 2018-01**

A **RESOLUTION** related to new Pilot Electric Vehicle Public Charging Stations, and rescinding Resolution 2017-04.

**WHEREAS**, On February 6, 2017 the City Council adopted Resolution No. 2017-04 to temporarily waive the City's electric utility customer charge for electric vehicle charging stations related to federal, state, or industry electric vehicle grant programs; and


**WHEREAS**, the temporary waiver only applied to the customer charge for municipal purposes included in ECC 9.91.100.H.3; and

**WHEREAS**, On September 20, 2017, after further consideration the Utility Advisory Committee recommended to City Council to discontinue the temporary waiver of the customer charge since the City will not own the charging station. In addition, the Utility Advisory Committee determined it would not be in the best interest of electric ratepayer to maintain a temporary waiver of the customer charge because tourists are anticipated to be the primary users of the electric vehicle charging stations;

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the City Council for the City of Ellensburg as follows:

**Section 1.** The City Council hereby rescinds Resolution No. 2017-04 which will discontinue the temporary waiver of the customer charge for electric vehicle charging stations that would have been in effect through February 6, 2022.
