

ORDINANCE NO. 4806

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELLENSBURG, WASHINGTON, RELATING TO CHAPTER 1.84 - "PUBLIC TRANSIT ADVISORY COMMITTEE" OF THE ELLENSBURG CITY CODE AND AMENDING SECTIONS 1.84.010, 1.84.020 AND 1.84.010.

WHEREAS, the Public Transit Advisory Committee was created in 2016 with five members; and

WHEREAS, at the June 20, 2018 meeting of the Public Transit Advisory Committee a motion was made and passed to increase committee membership by two, and propose additional minor code changes;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Ellensburg, Washington do hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1. Section 1.84.010 of the Ellensburg City Code, and Section 1 of Ordinance 4731, is hereby amended to read as follows:

1.84.010 Creation and purpose.

There is created a public transit advisory committee consisting of ~~five~~ seven members who shall be appointed by the mayor and approved by a majority vote of the city council. The purpose of the public transit advisory committee is to oversee public transit services in the city, including the quality of services, providing direction for public information and education, developing and making recommendations on system improvements and funding, and reporting to council on those and other elements as directed. Section 2. Section 1.84.020 of the Ellensburg City Code, and Section 1 of Ordinance 4731, is hereby amended to read as follows:

1.84.020 Appointment – Terms – Composition.

Members of the public transit advisory committee shall not receive compensation for their service. The mayor shall appoint each member for a three-year term subject to confirmation by the city council, and member representation is as follows:

A. ~~One city council member, and a representative recommended for appointment (or their designee) by the Associated Students of Central Washington University (ASCWU) Student Government, whose initial terms shall expire June 30, 2017.~~

B. A representative from Central Washington University who shall represent the general interests of CWU and be designated by CWU Administration.

C. A representative of the Associated Students of Central Washington University (ASCWU) Student Government to serve a minimum of one year, whose term shall correspond to the terms of office of students elected to serve on the ASCWU Student Government.

~~D. and two~~ Four community members, ~~serve three year terms each as members of the committee, whose terms shall expire December 31, 2018. Community members 1 and 2 shall serve terms expiring December 31, 2018. Community member 3 shall serve a term expiring December 31, 2019. Community member 4 shall serve a term expiring December 31, 2020.~~ Thereafter, all terms under this subsection shall be three years.

Section 3. Section 1.84.040 of the Ellensburg City Code and Section 1 of Ordinance 4731 is hereby amended to read as follows:

1.84.040 Organization – Meetings – Quorum.


The city council member appointed to the committee shall serve as chairperson. Immediately after their appointment, members of the committee shall meet and organize by electing from all the members of the committee a vice chairperson. An election of such officer shall be conducted at the first meeting of each calendar year. The public works and utilities director, or his/her designee, shall serve as secretary of the committee. The secretary shall be entitled to participate in the deliberations of the committee, but shall have no vote. It shall be the duty of the chairperson to preside at all meetings of the committee and of the secretary to keep minutes of all meetings and of all proceedings of the committee. The vice chairperson shall perform the duties of the chairperson in the event of the absence of the chairperson or vacancy in the office. ~~Three~~ Four committee members shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business. The affirmative votes by a majority of the quorum shall be necessary to carry any proposition. There shall be a fixed time and place of meetings within the corporate limits of the city of Ellensburg at least once each calendar month. The meeting time and place shall be made known to the public and all regular meetings of the committee shall be open to the public. [Ord. 4731 § 1, 2016.]

Section 4. Severability. If any portion of this ordinance is declared invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion(s) of this ordinance.

Section 5. Corrections. Upon the approval of the City Attorney, the City Clerk and the codifiers of this ordinance are authorized to make necessary corrections to this ordinance including, but not limited to, the correction of scrivener's/clerical errors, references, ordinance numbering, section/subsection numbers and any references thereto.


Section 6. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage, approval and publication.


