

The Ellensburg Arts Commission seeks designs in response to the year 2020 for glass panels to be placed on a bus shelter on 3rd Ave in front of the Ellensburg Public Library.

One artist will be selected to design glass panels. The bus shelter comprises of four panels that measure roughly 25" x 44" each. Panel designs will consist of four panels in a single rectangle on the back wall of the shelter totaling approximately 60" x 90". The finished panels will have the final design printed in full color on glass by a local contractor. The Ellensburg Arts Commission will pay for printing cost. The artist retains the rights to the image, but the City of Ellensburg will own the finished panels and retain the ability to use images in promotional materials. The drawing on the following page depicts the shelter to be placed on 3rd Ave in front of the Ellensburg City Library.

Stipend:

Artist(s) will receive a \$500 stipend if their work is selected and subject to mutually agreeable contract terms.

To Submit:

Artists should submit up to five samples of artwork to show, plus one concept design for the bus shelter to ellensburgarts@ci.ellensburg.wa.us along with an artist statement and resume.

Submission Guidelines:

Submission File Format: JPEG only

File dimensions: No smaller than 1920 pixels on the longest side

File resolution: 72 ppi/dpi (standard web resolution)

File size: 5 MB maximum

Qualifications: Preference given to artists residing in the City of Ellensburg. Work must be made within the past three years.

Evaluation: Work will be evaluated on strength of design and ease to translate onto glass.

Timeline: Deadline for submissions: Feb. 8, 2021

Notification: March 2, 2021

Final design from selected artist due to contractor: March 19, 2021

Installation of design: March/April 2021
