



Computer Use Policy

Ellensburg Public Library

Use of the public computer workstations in the Library is subject to the Ellensburg Public Library's Rule of Conduct:

Due to the nature of the library, we expect patrons to conduct themselves in a manner that does not interfere or interrupt others working in the library.

We appreciate your consideration for our library environment.

By clicking OK, I agree to the following:

- Patrons using computers in the adult Lab are allowed 2 sessions per day of 60 minutes each. Extra time may be added at the discretion of library staff if the lab is not busy.
- Patrons using Youth computers are allowed 2 sessions per day of 40 minutes each.
- Access the computer only with your own library card or a guest pass, if you do not have a library card or computer use card.
- Follow the directions of staff.
- Printing is \$.10 per page and paid at the Print Release Station.
- Personal files may be saved to your own USB drive. Files saved to the computer will be erased.
- Children under the age of 8 must have a parent/guardian present and ready to assist them at the computer. Children 8 years old and older must have an Internet Use Consent Form signed by a parent or guardian on file with the library.
- Use of the Internet in the library is a service to the public and inappropriate use will result in a suspension of this privilege. No illegal or obscene materials may be accessed as defined in WA RCW Title 9, Chapter 9.68. Display of pornographic or sexually explicit images is not appropriate use of library computers.
- Disruptive behavior defined in the Library's "Code of Conduct" or sites that interfere with others using the library or staff working in the area, is not allowed and will result in suspension of use.
