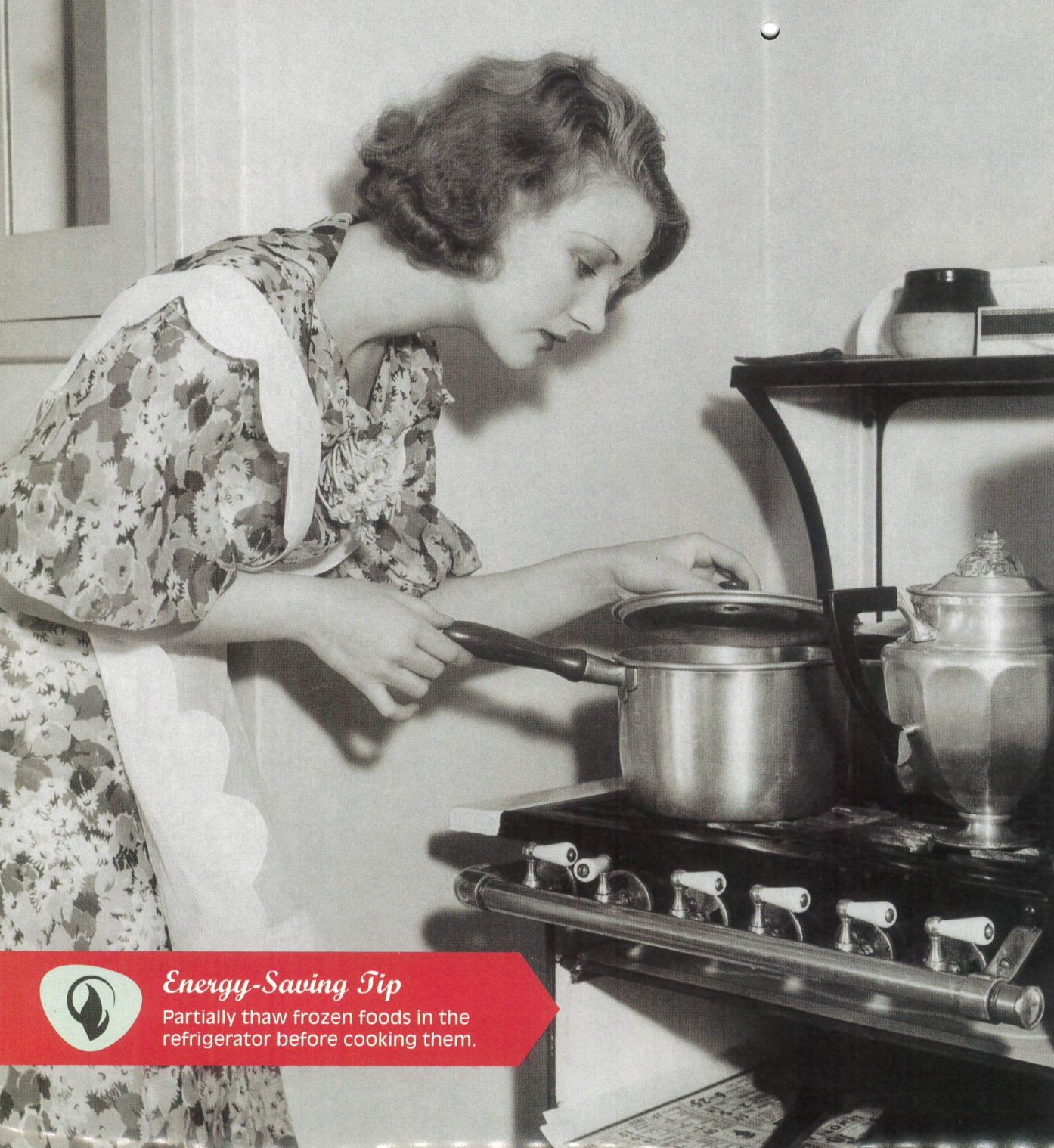

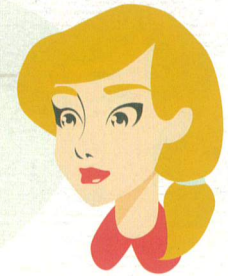
Partially thaw frozen foods in the refrigerator before cooking them.

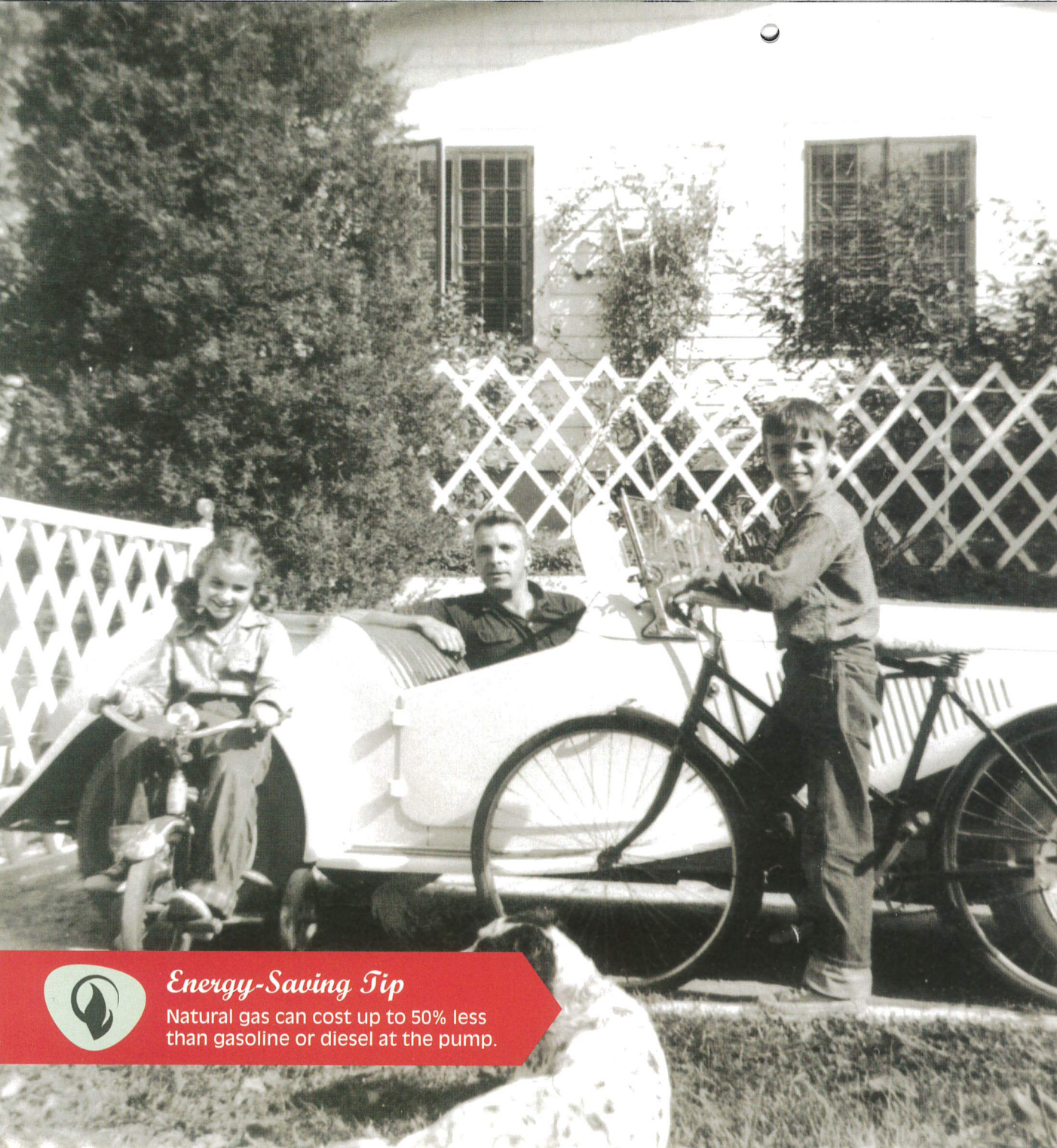

Natural Gas *Clothes Dryers*

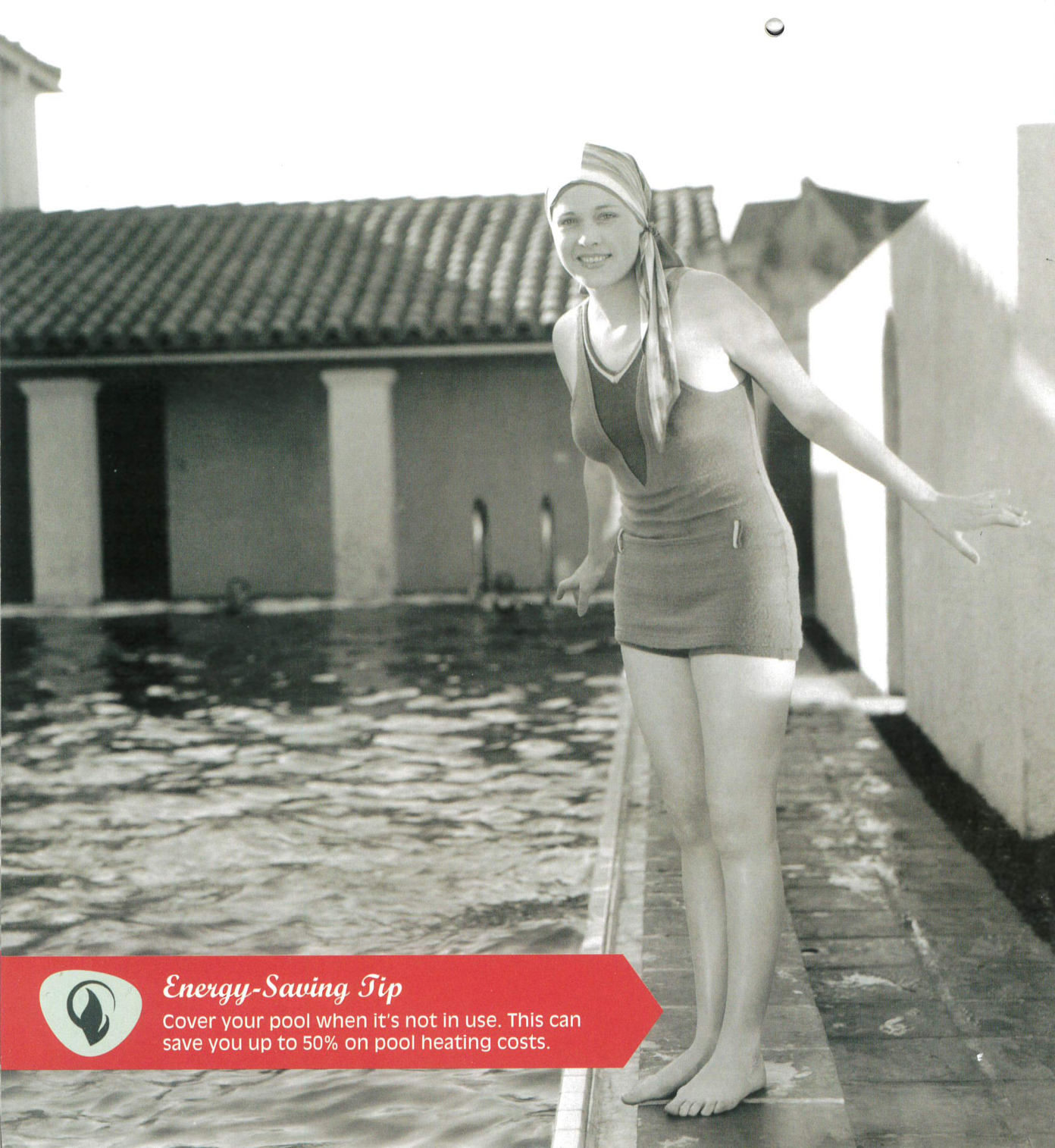

Natural Gas *Generators*

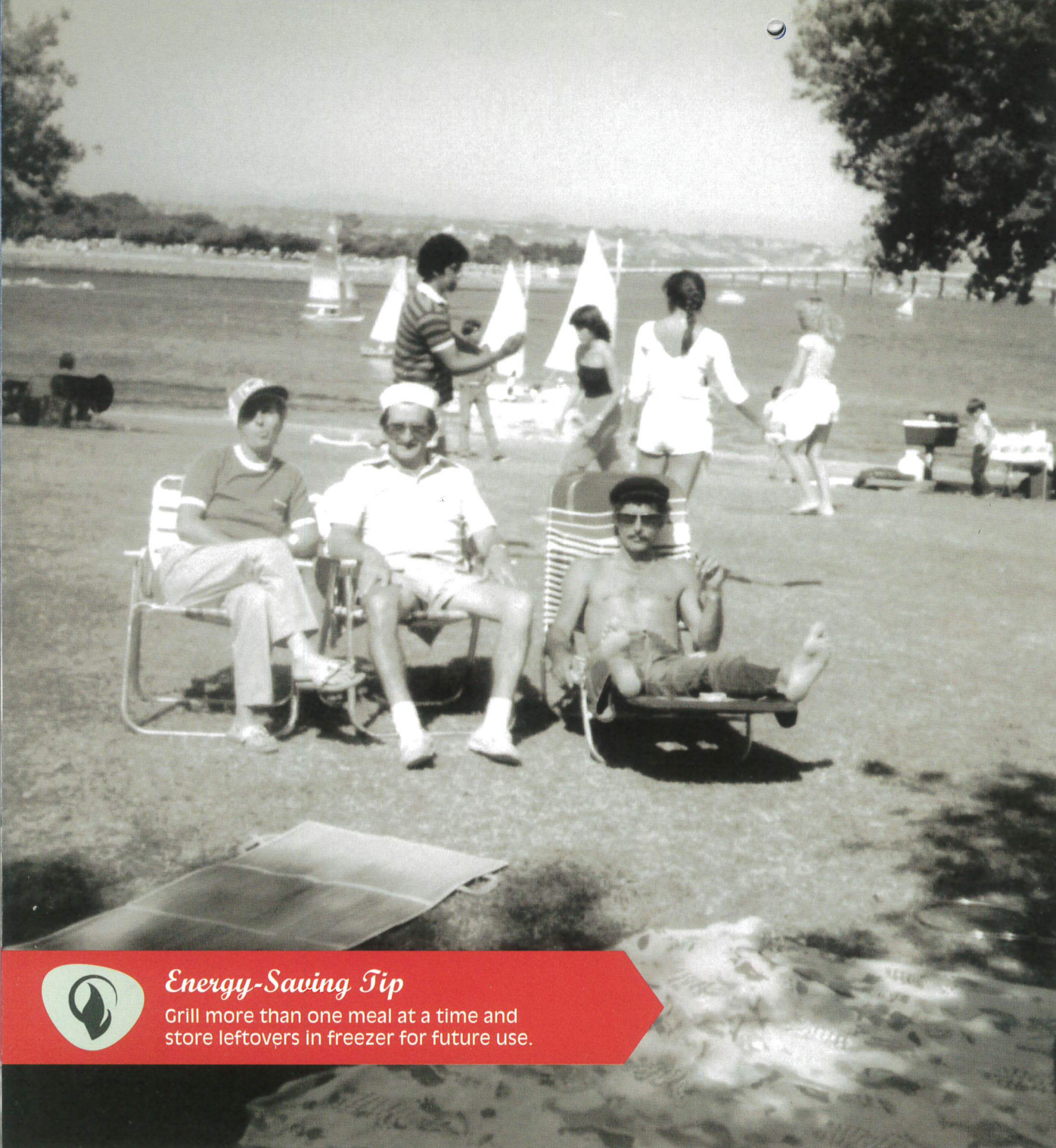

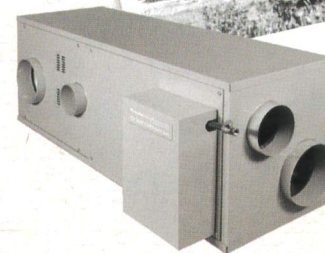

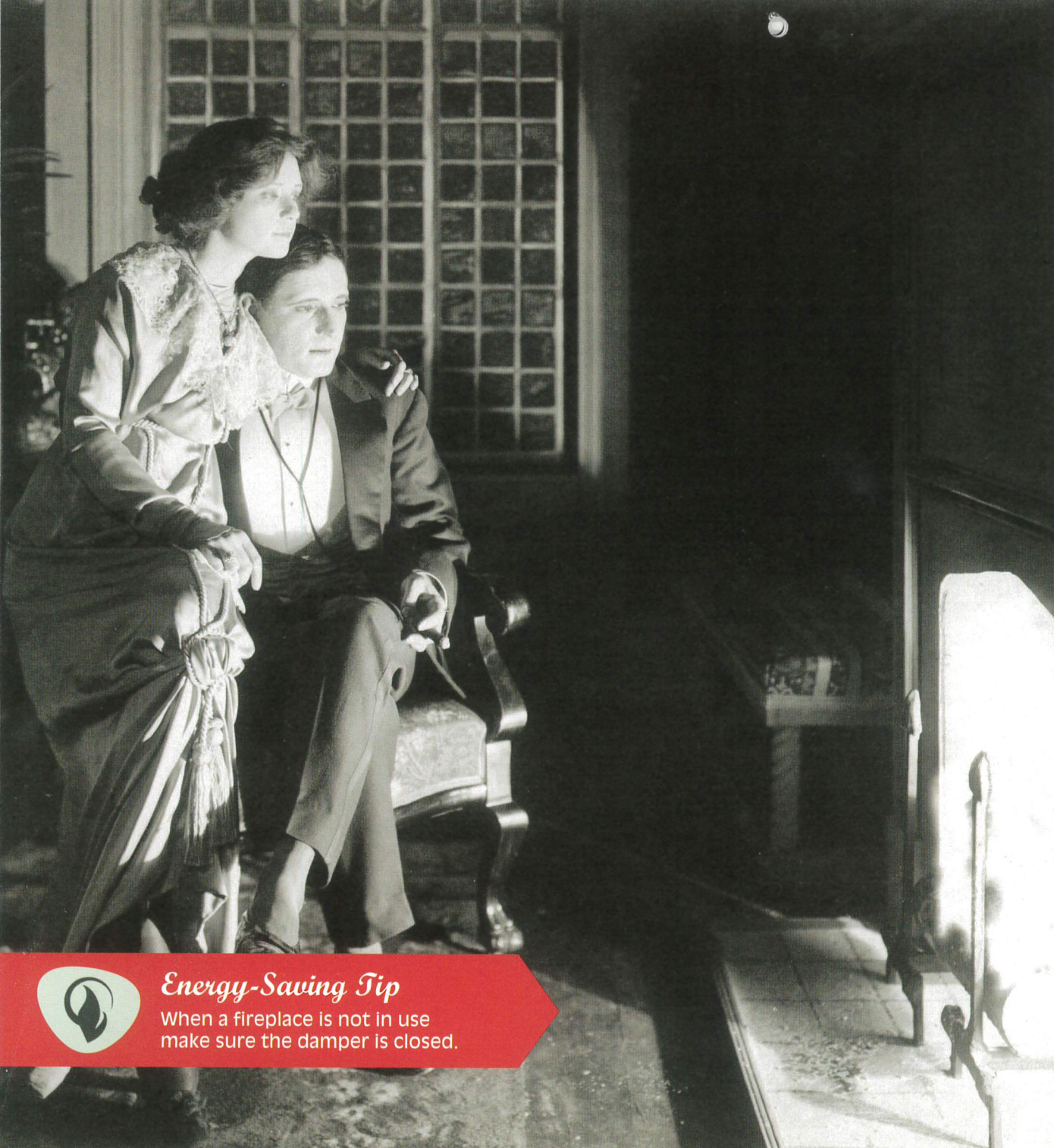
Keep windows and doors closed to prevent heated/cooled air from escaping.

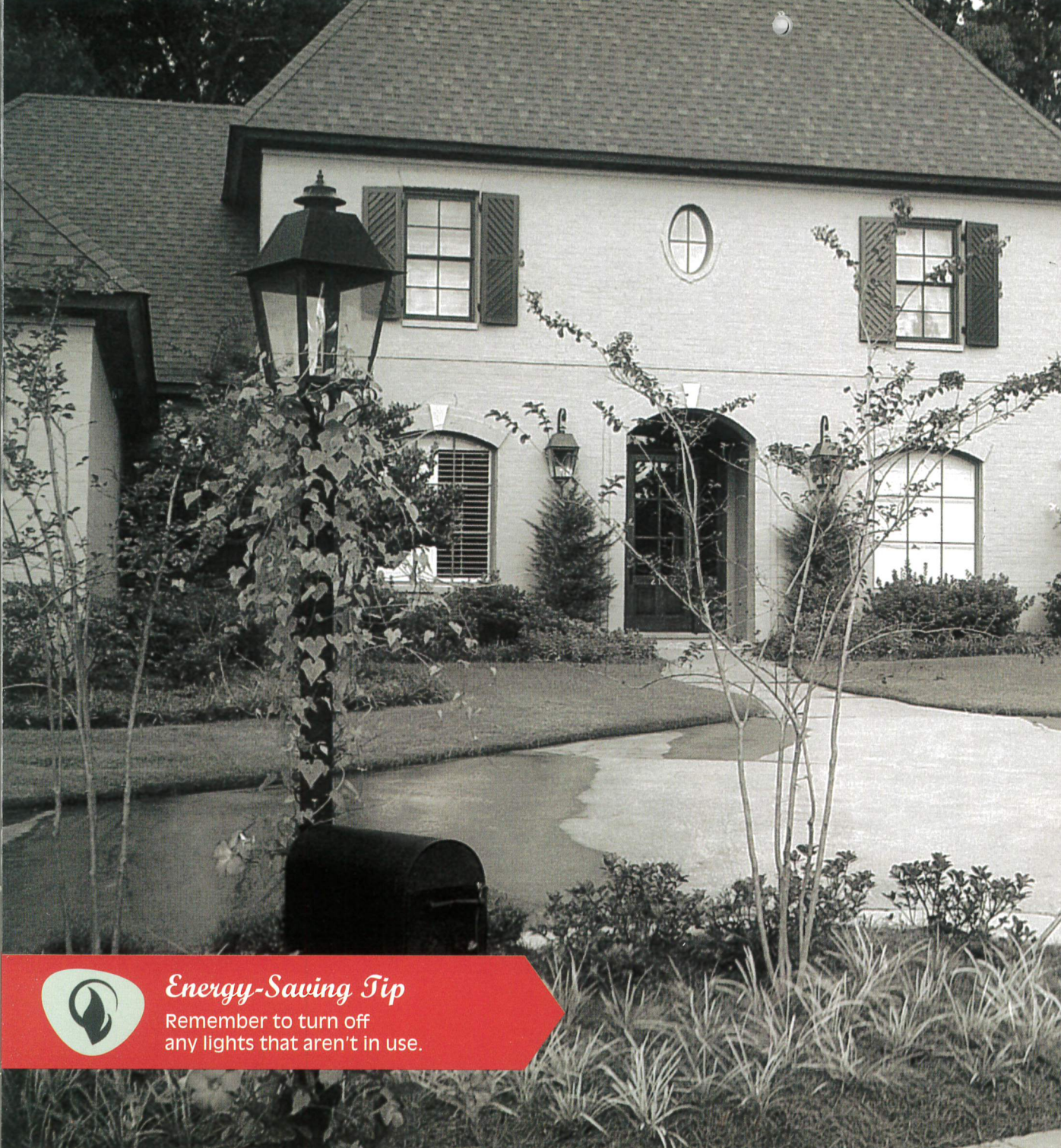
