Key Features <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Traffic flow remains the same as current• Maintains the highest number of parking stalls (12) near the water tower• Keeps on-street parking configuration near the Legion Hall• Adds paved pedestrian pathway through the park• Single stall flush restroom• Four picnic table/bench areas at the overlook parking	Key Features <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Traffic flow the same as current• Reduces parking stalls near the water tower to 10• Creates 26 parking stalls (parallel and pull-in) near the American Legion• Adds seating plaza area added• Paved pedestrian pathway through the park• Single stall flush restroom• Four picnic table/bench areas at the overlook parking	Key Features <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Eliminates the loop near the water tower• Creates two-way local traffic only for residents who live on the east of the park• Retains four current overlook parking stalls• Adds 15 parking stalls near the American Legion• Creates a larger open grass area near the water tower• Creates a hammerhead turnaround near the water tower• Paved pedestrian pathway throughout the park• Single stall flush restroom• Three picnic table/bench areas at the current overlook parking area	Key Features <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Overlook parking has been shifted near the American Legion• Eliminates loop near the water tower• Creates two-way local traffic only for residents who live on the east of the park• Creates largest open grass area near the water tower• Creates a hammerhead turnaround near the water tower• Single stall flush restroom• Paved pedestrian pathway throughout the park• Four picnic table/bench areas at the greenspace overlook area
