



City of Ellensburg Boys 1st to 8th Grade Youth Basketball League



The City of Ellensburg Youth Basketball League is focused on teaching the proper fundamentals of basketball to youth in kindergarten through 8th grade in a positive environment. The Youth Basketball League is divided into two seasons:

- **Girls 1st to 8th grade & Coed Kindergarten season: October 8, 2018 to December 15, 2018.**
- **Boys 1st to 8th grade season: January 7 to March 9, 2019.**
 - Registration is open October 29 through December 7, 2018.

Boys 1st to 8th Grade Youth Basketball League:

League Dates: January 7 to March 9, 2019.

- Youth in 1st through 8th grade will participate in a **7 game league**, with games taking place Saturday mornings at Ellensburg School District Facilities.
- **Player Drafts:** January 7 and January 9, 2019 – 4th to 8th graders only
- **Practices:** Begin the week of January 14, 2019.
- **Games:** Games will begin January 26 and end March 9, 2019.

Online Registration:

Boys 1st through 8th Grade Registration:

- **Early Registration:** October 29, through November 30, 2018 The Early Registration fee is **\$65** per child.
 - **Multi-Child Discount:** During Early Registration, families registering multiple siblings will receive a discounted rate of **\$60** for each additional sibling.
- **Late Registration:** December 1 through December 7, 2018. The late registration fee is **\$85** per child. Multi-child discounts do not apply to late registrations.
- Youth Recreation Scholarships are available through HopeSource (509) 925-1448.
- Early and Late Registration will take place at the Stan Bassett Youth Center Monday through Friday from 1:00 pm to 7:00 pm. Credit/debit cards, cash, or check is accepted.

Coaches:

- Volunteer head and assistant coaches are needed for all teams. Coaches will lead 1 to 2 practices per week and manage games. Individuals with a love for sports and enjoy working with youth, are encouraged to volunteer.
