

Summary of Community input May 7, 2015 for the five concept master plans:

Kiwanis Park:

Group 1:

- Note: Group thought base map not correct for elements at the park site
- skate Court moved to play plaza/restroom location
- Restrooms(#7) and swings moved to Basketball Court
- Basketball Court moved to skate court areas (full court on north area and ½ court east of parking and south of “full” court
- At the new ½ court site add a picnic area
- Restroom could also be relocated on east side of park along North B Street mid-way up and north of proposed trees
- Add a Dog Space along “B” Street along the trails/sidewalk under the proposed three trees on east side of park
- No comments on #1,#3,#4,#5,#9,#10,#11,#13
- Added need for bike racks

Group #2:

- This park seems heavily used by kids, so expand play areas (#6)
- Good idea to move play space away from road
- Shade trees to protect skaters (#12)

Group 3:

- Keep skate park on the edge
- #12 Keep as is like the design
- Keep little kids in a safe zone (area of the park)

Irene Rinehart Park:

Carey Lake area:

Group 1:

- Add bike racks

Group 3:

- Site picnic shelters & Structures with wind in mind, need protection

Undeveloped western park area:

Group 1:

- Add bike racks
- No need for this and not feasible for traffic and would over use area
- A “better use: Activity-Bike Park?, Obstacle course/Stn

Group 2:

- Too much development/ugly, too close to road (#6)
- We like the drift boat ramp (#1)
- Close park at 10pm
- Too much hassle/introduces litter & enforcement issues.
- Create a private campground elsewhere is better
- Instead landscape/restoration project is a better idea
- Trails well used in this area, extend them.
- Add a dog park in the center of the area proposed for the campgrounds

Group 3:

- #6 access road “too far on too narrow road for drift boat trailers sharing road with other Carey Lake traffic
- Already adequate launch facilities

Memorial Park:

Group 1:

- Add ADA Fragrance Park between existing parking (#4) and light #5. (Make sure located away from green space where flying balls etc. might damage plants or perhaps flanking trail (#9) or elsewhere.
- At the #2 play plaza: “A spray park would work better here rather than at Mt. View
- Relocation of the light #5 “good idea”

Group 2:

- Like idea to rebuild in same #8: “Remodel Shelters & Storage Unit”

Mt. View Park:

Group 1:

- Bike racks
- Edible landscapes
- Outdoor Amphitheatre (for movies & plays)

Group 2:

- Build Community Center someplace else/no really enough space for such a complex
- Keep tennis

Group 3:

- See “red marked” designs for the site: East edge along Willow: “Buffer to keep balls off road/parking” South side along Seattle; “Buffer from light. Issues with neighbors” Western area of park with existing trees serves as a “wind protected side/take advantage”; “Move the Community Center structure westerly to take advantage of the “most wind protected area”; see design: “move bathrooms and picnic shelter” west of the proposed center building

Reed Park:

Design (A) with green lawn strip along northern edge:

Group 1:

- Add bike racks

Group 2:

- No thanks???

Group 3:

- Restroom “great”
- #5 Shelter/Performance Canopy “Great”
- Doesn’t solve problem-high school drivers/vehicles

Design (B) with green sections between parking stalls #6 on north edge:
