- Duct Sealing & Duct Insulation (up to \$1.25 per Lin.Ft.)
- Wall Insulation (Up to \$0.35 per Sq.Ft.)
- Commercial Lighting
- Heat Pump (Ductless, Water Heating, Air Source)

General Qualifications:

- Weatherization applies to existing electrically heated single family or multifamily site built housing and commercial business buildings
- Electricity must be primary source of heat for rebates
- Portable electric heaters do not qualify as primary electric heating
- Must install weatherization measures to comply with all program requirements as well as federal, state, and local codes
- New Construction, Manufactured Homes or Mobile Homes may not be eligible for all programs
- Natural Gas Heated Customers are only eligible for Air Source Heat Pumps added to a ducted system
- Commercial lighting rebates are case by case and requires a lighting audit by City staff and proposed lighting equipment upgrades to see if applicant qualifies
- Multi-Family Housing complexes qualify for exterior lighting upgrades

Rebate Process:

- 1) Complete application for rebate
- 2) Send to Energy Services for review and rebate offer
- 3) Review specifications and terms of rebate including certified heat pump installers and qualified equipment
- 4) Sign rebate agreement
- 5) Secure building permit and complete work (or hire contractor to complete work) including building permit final inspection
- 6) Submit final invoice to Energy Services along with building permit inspection
- 7) Energy Services staff verifies work completed to specifications and submits for City payment
- 8) Customer receives rebate check in the mail (approximately 30 days)
